## **Fire Accident at the Toyama Plant (1st Report)**

Nissan Chemical Corporation is afraid to announce that a fire accident occurred at our Toyama Plant (Sasakura 635, Fuchu-machi, Toyama City, Toyama Prefecture), which manufactures chemical products, around 4:30 a.m. today.

We deeply apologize for the great inconvenience and concern caused to the residents in the neighborhood and all those involved. The situation has become clear as of today at 15:00, as follows.

### **1. Location of the occurrence**

Our general warehouse in the Toyama Plant

### **2. Time of occurrence**

Date of occurrence: Around 4:30 a.m on Friday, June 12, the product in the general warehouse caught fire.

Fire extinguishment time: Around 8:39 a.m. on the same day, a public firefighter confirmed the fire extinguishment.

### **3. Damage status**

Human damage: None

Property Damage: Detailed investigation underway

### **4. Environmental Impact**

Although chlorine-based gases were temporarily generated, these gases were not detected outside the plant premises.

### **5. Neighborhood impact**

There was a delay in attending school at an elementary school and a junior high school near the plant.

### **6. Cause and countermeasure**

The cause is unknown. As soon as the cause is discovered, we will take appropriate measures under the guidance of the firefighting authorities.
