**Announcement of COVID-19 infection in our group company**

Nissan Chemical Corporation regrets to announce that one employee (hereafter “the employee”) of our U.S. subsidiary, Nissan Chemical America Corporation (President: William L. Smith; hereafter “NCA”) contracted COVID-19. The employee works at NCA’s Pasadena Plant (Texas; hereafter “the relevant site”).

On October 28<sup>th</sup> (local time; the same applies hereafter), the employee wasn’t feeling well. On October 30<sup>th</sup>, the employee tested positive for COVID-19 and informed NCA. At present the employee quarantines at home and is in a stable condition.

On October 30<sup>th</sup> the relevant site was temporarily shutdown, and resumed operations the next day by employees testing negative after a deep disinfection. In addition, this incident will have no impact on our business.

Going forward our group will continue to work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 placing top priority on the safety of our employees and business partners. We would like to ask the understanding of all those involved in this endeavor.
