Announcement of COVID-19 infection in our company

Nissan Chemical Corporation (Head Office: Chuo-ku, Tokyo; President: KINOSHITA Kojiro; hereafter “Nissan Chemical”) regrets to announce that one employee (hereafter “the employee”) contracted COVID-19. The employee works at Nissan Chemical’s Toyama Plant (Toyama City, Toyama; hereafter “the relevant site”).

On January 5th the employee was identified as close contact of an infected person by the public health center. On January 8th the employee tested positive for COVID-19 and informed Nissan Chemical. At present the employee is quarantined at an accommodation designated by the public health center and is in a stable condition.

Nissan Chemical assigns three employees who are identified as close contact of the employee by the public health center to standby at home, and is monitoring their health status.

Four employees stated above have worked inside the relevant site basically.

Nissan Chemical, especially its COVID-19 response headquarters headed by CRO, will continue to take appropriate actions based on government policies and others.

The employee’s work area in the relevant site was disinfected temporarily by Nissan Chemical ourselves on January 8th and thoroughly by a vendor on January 10th.

The relevant site and the others of Nissan Chemical are operating as normal with enhanced measures to prevent COVID-19. In addition, as a result of the cooperation with various related parties, this incident has no impact on our business.

Going forward we will continue to work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 placing top priority on safety of our employees and business partners. We would like to ask the understanding of all those involved in this endeavor.
