Announcement of COVID-19 infection in our company

Nissan Chemical Corporation (Head Office: Chuo-ku, Tokyo; President: YAGI Shinsuke; hereafter “the Company”) regrets to announce that one employee (hereafter “the Employee”) contracted COVID-19. The Employee works at the Company’s Head Office (Chuo-ku, Tokyo; hereafter “the Relevant Site”).

On the night of May 7th the Employee started feeling sick. The next day the Employee tested positive for COVID-19 and informed the Company. At present the Employee is quarantined at home and is in a stable condition. No employee is identified as close contact with the Employee by the public health center.

The Company, especially its COVID-19 response headquarters headed by CRO, will continue to take appropriate actions based on government policies and others.

The Employee’s work area in the Relevant Site was disinfected thoroughly by a vendor on May 9th. The Relevant Site and the others of the Company are operating as normal with enhanced measures to prevent COVID-19. In addition, as a result of the cooperation with various related parties, this incident has no impact on our business.

Going forward we will continue to work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 placing top priority on safety of our employees and business partners. We would like to ask the understanding of all those involved in this endeavor.
