Announcement of COVID-19 infection in our company

Nissan Chemical Corporation (Head Office: Chuo-ku, Tokyo; President: YAGI Shinsuke; hereafter “the Company”) regrets to announce that two employees* (hereafter “the Employees”) are infected with COVID-19. The Employees are in charge of chemical manufacturing in the Chemicals Division at the Company’s Toyama Plant (Toyama City, Toyama). The public health center had identified seven employees as close contacts and keep them on hold at home, and the Company has monitored their health status.

*One employee informed the Company on August 18th and one employee did on August 21st.

Nissan Chemical, especially its COVID-19 response headquarters headed by CRO, will continue to take appropriate action based on government policies and others.

The Employees’ work area (hereafter “the Area”) was disinfected thoroughly by a vendor on August 20th. The other offices and plants than the Area are operating as normal with enhanced measures to prevent COVID-19.

We will continue to work to prevent the spread of COVID-19 placing top priority on safety of our employees and business partners. We would appreciate the understanding of all those involved in this endeavor.
