COVID-19 infection outbreaks in the Company and effects of the infection on operation

Nissan Chemical Corporation (headquartered in Chuo-ku, Tokyo; President, YAGI Shinsuke) (hereinafter "the Company") announces that effects of the infection of six (6) employees with COVID-19 on operation were found. The six employees of the Company (hereinafter "the Employees") are in charge of chemical manufacturing of the Chemical Division at the Company's Toyama Plant (Toyama City, Toyama).

All of the Employees had positive tests for COVID-19, and were tested positive between August 7th and August 10th.

Due to the above, from the point view of maintaining safe/stable operation and preventing the spread of COVID-19 infection, the Company has decided to suspend operation of its urea plant from August 10th until around August 20th. Incidentally, the other plants are operated as usual.

In connection with shipment of related products along with the suspension, we will make adjustments as much as possible not to cause any effect on our customers.

We will continue to make efforts to prevent the outbreak and spread of COVID-19 infection, while prioritizing the safety of our employees and customers the most. We appreciate for your understanding.
