Effect of Noto Peninsula Earthquake in 2024 at Toyama Factory (1)

We, Nissan Chemical Corporation, would like to express our sincere condolences and sympathy toward those who affected by Noto Peninsula Earthquake on January 1, 2024, and also to pray for the earliest restoration of the disaster-stricken areas.

Due to the earthquake, a minor and partial damage was found to ammonia production facility at our Toyama Factory (635, Sasakura, Fuchu-machi, Toyama). There are no injuries and no environmental effect at the moment.

The summary based on the latest information is as follows.

1. Production of Ammonia

As a minor and partial damage occurred to the ammonia production facility, its operation was suspended on January 5.

2. Productions of Urea, Nitric Acid, and other ammonia derivatives

Due to the suspension of ammonia facility, other plants related to ammonia would be shut down in a sequential order.

3. Production Restart Date

The extent of the damage to the facility is under investigation and we will make the earliest announcement when the production is ready to start safely.

4. Financial Impact

Currently under investigation.

Remarks: There is no damage confirmed to other main production facilities such as display materials and semiconductor materials.
