Effect of Noto Peninsula Earthquake in 2024 at Toyama Factory (2nd report)

We, Nissan Chemical Corporation, would like to express our sincere condolences and sympathy toward those who affected by Noto Peninsula Earthquake on January 1, 2024, and also to pray for the earliest restoration in disaster-stricken areas.

As reported on January 5th at our web page, the operation of ammonia production facility at our Toyama Factory (635, Sasakura, Fuchu-machi, Toyama) was suspended. As of today, we have a plan to restart the operation as described below.

There are no injuries and no environmental effect at the moment.

1. Production of Ammonia

Due to the minor and partial damage of the ammonia production facility, its operation was suspended on January 5. Now it is announced that the production is scheduled to be resumed by the end of January.

2. Productions of Urea, Nitric Acid, and other ammonia derivatives

After the restart of ammonia production, other facilities related to ammonia would be resumed in a sequential order.

3. Financial Impact

There is minimal effect estimated to the current financial period.
