Notice Regarding Unauthorized Access to Our Systems

We have recently identified an incident involving unauthorized access to our systems. While it is expected that a full assessment of the incident will take some time, we would like to provide an update based on the information currently available. We sincerely apologize for any concern and inconvenience this situation may cause to our stakeholders.

1. Overview

On July 1, 2026, we detected suspicious activity within our systems. Following an internal investigation, we determined that there is a possibility that unauthorized access by a third party had occurred.

We are currently working with external cybersecurity experts to investigate the root cause of the incident and assess its scope and potential impact.

2. Current Status and Actions

Upon identifying the incident, we promptly implemented the necessary measures to contain the situation, prevent further unauthorized activity, and mitigate the risk of recurrence. We have also strengthened our monitoring and security controls.

At this time, no impact on our customers or business partners has been confirmed. However, our investigation remains ongoing.

3. Next Steps

We will continue to work closely with external experts to determine the cause of the incident and assess its full impact. If we discover any new facts, we will disclose them promptly.
